

Twin Turnip Garden 2026 CSA – Sign up by March 31, 2026

Hello Friends-

It's time to sign up for the 2026 Twin Turnip Garden CSA (Community-Supported Agriculture)! We'll be providing mostly seasonal produce, and some flowers.

Here's what we're excited to grow for you this season:

Broccoli, Kale, Collards

Lettuce, Spinach, Sorrel, Arugula, Cucumber

Beets, Kohlrabi, Potatoes, Carrots

Sage, Rosemary, Thyme, Oregano, Basil

Dill, Parsley, Cilantro

Green Onion, Yellow Onion, Leek, Chives, Garlic

Tomatoes, Tomatillos, Winter Squash, Pie Pumpkins

Dry Beans, Green Beans

Sweet corn, Popcorn

Cut flowers

How does a CSA work?

This year we are looking to provide 20 shares to those in our community. Each share (family, individual) will receive about 22 boxes, one per week, with \$20 or more worth of produce from Mid-May through October. Each share will cost \$440, \$240 collected by the end of March and the remainder in October. By providing a deposit, you will be directly supporting our farming efforts to be able to provide the best quality produce for you. The latter half will be collected in October so if we fall short, you won't be charged for food you didn't get.

How will I receive my produce box?

We know your time is valuable and want you to receive your weekly boxes without difficulty. To our friends near Old Fairhaven Parkway, we'll deliver for free. For those further, there will be a delivery charge that can be discussed. You'll also be able to come pick the boxes up in Fairhaven in the morning of delivery day. For those with close friends and neighbors, we could leave multiple boxes at each house for your convenience. Of course, anyone can pick up from our farm in Mount Vernon with notice. Boxes will be delivered weekly from mid-May to October.

Information about your farmers:

Our farm is a one-third-acre garden within a 36 acre tree farm in the heart of Skagit Valley that is steadily being transformed back into a native forest. We use completely organic practices with minimal use of petroleum products, including plastic. Courtney and Dylan are the only workers this year.
